

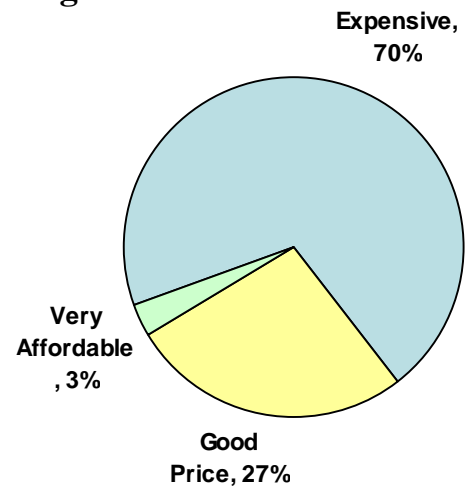
# NEWARK HOUSING AUTHORITY

## 2008 COMMUNITY SURVEY RESULTS

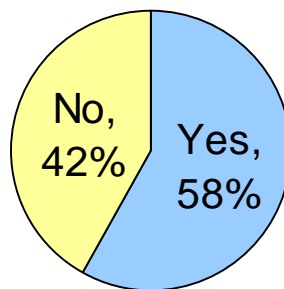
The Newark Housing Authority surveyed visitors to our booth at Newark Community Day on September 14, 2008. Survey results indicate that members of the community overwhelmingly believe that housing prices in Newark are expensive and that there is insufficient affordable housing supply.

The greatest community housing needs selected by survey participants include affordable housing, housing near transportation and walkable communities. Despite current trends to increase student housing in Newark, student housing received the fewest responses. Participants identified several other important housing concerns, which are detailed in the graphs below.

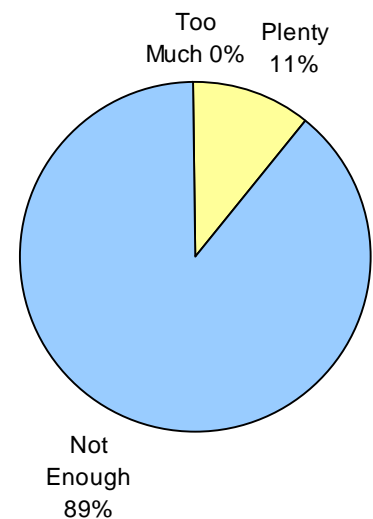
### What do you think about the cost of housing in Newark?



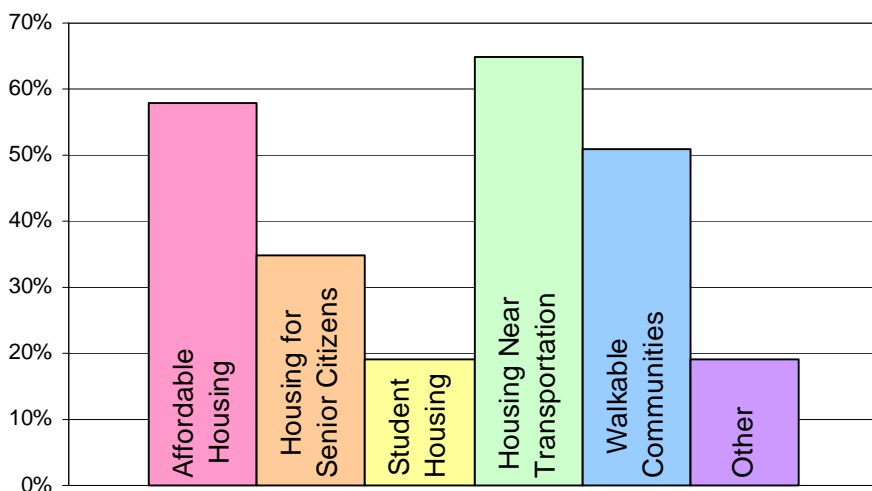
### Did you know that Newark had a Housing Authority?
